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NARRATIVE: Thanks to the OHRAB grant, The Shaker Historical Society has been able to dramatically improve its ability to serve researchers interested in maps and stereoviews by reorganizing, indexing and photographing all maps and stereoviews in the Elizabeth B. Nord Library & Archives. We also have had the opportunity to educate interns about the proper way to handle, organize, document and index archival collections. By funding materials, the OHRAB has enabled us to encapsulate 105 maps (repair some tears prior to encapsulation in Mylar), reorganize and index 99.8% of the maps, and photograph about 76% of them. Through this project we have also photographed and indexed all 1229 stereoview cards in the collection. Our source for archival sleeves has been out of stock, so we will complete the reorganization of the stereoviews alphabetically by publisher when we receive the archival sleeves next week.

Narrative of self-assessment:

So far we are on target to achieve all objectives set out in our application. I have no criticisms so far about the map or stereoview finding aids and reorganization. We also reorganized and indexed the scrapbook collection though I am disappointed with the quality of images from the scrapbooks, and suspect that we will need to redo that process. Reorganizing and indexing the scrapbooks was not part of our remit, but as we were already embarking on the process to teach interns about writing finding aids and handling archival material, we included work on the scrapbook collection as well. We still plan on adding our collections to our website, so that they are searchable by an international audience, but given the volume of images, we will need to do some research as to how best to handle the images. PastPerfect's web software may be a way forward for us to progress beyond the work promised in our application. For now, we have added blog entries on our website and articles in our newsletter, *The Journal*.
