# **Summary of Project Activities and Accomplishments:**

Implementation of the Improving Access to Sinclair Community College Archives Historical Records Project, awarded to Sinclair Community College by the Ohio Historical Records Advisory Board, began in March 2011. The Project Director's initial task was to hire a qualified person to perform the project activities. The first step required development of a job description (based on the grant responsibilities) and determination by Sinclair's Human Resources Department of an appropriate hourly rate. During the month of May, the search committee interviewed three candidates for the part time position. All three candidates were graduate students in the Wright State University Public History Program and all were qualified. Misti Spillman was selected as the part time employee.

Misti's first day of work was June 1, 2011. After an orientation of the campus and the department, the Project Director reviewed the grant goals and activities with Misti. As stated in the grant application, the first and primary goal was to provide increased access to the archival records of the Sinclair Community College Archives with special focus on the historical photographs. Photographs are one of the most requested records in the archives. Each photograph is stored in an archival folder. The process Misti employed in order to work towards this goal included a physical review of each individual photograph, assessment of its condition, and a determination of the description to be recorded on each photograph/folder. The step-by-step process included completion of any additions or corrections on the folder or photograph upon discovery. After the review process, the information for each photograph was added to the existing ACCESS database which identifies all archival and non-archival records stored within the department.

Misti worked a total of 180 hours on the project. In all, 44 document cases (approximately 15 cubic feet of records) were systematically reviewed and added to ACCESS database. Furthermore, this work represents 2,472 photographs/folders. Misti added all the photographs not previously entered to the database with specific information pertaining to each item. As a result of this project, keyword searches can now be made for individual names, events, buildings, etc. (See attached examples of database entries.)

The project *accomplished the primary goal* of improved access of photographs and other archival materials. Doing so, however, required expenditure of the entire budget allocated for the grant. In order to complete the work improving access to the historical photographs, the director of the Library appropriated an additional amount of \$138 from the Library's budget to complete the data entry of the last 2 boxes. Thus, the second goal of the project - to transfer other archival records (primarily president's files) to proper boxes/folders - was not undertaken in this grant project due to insufficient funds.

The grant was an overwhelming success. The accomplishments achieved could have never been completed using existing staff. Access to the historical photographs in the Sinclair Community College archival collection has been greatly enhanced. The following incident describes an example of the project's impact. Prior to the start of the OHRAB grant period, the archives received a request from the president's office seeking information and specifically photographs

about a former foundation trustee board member and prominent Daytonian. This individual had recently passed away and the information needed was for the pending memorial service. At that time, approximately four photographs were located in the archives collection. Since the completion of the grant and the subsequent indexing and data entry of all the photographs, a search for same individual yielded an additional eight items for a total of 12 items.

Sinclair Community College will be celebrating its 125<sup>th</sup> birthday in 2012. In preparation, Sinclair has hired a part time employee and constituted an advisory board. One of the numerous activities being planned for this celebration is an historical perspective of the last ten to fifteen years that will bring Sinclair's written history up to date. In addition to significant historical developments over this time period, many photographs will be utilized in this document. Another idea under consideration for the celebration is a historical exhibit of photographs. The work accomplished as a result of this grant has made immense impact on the research for these projects. The ability to perform keyword searches successfully for individual names, events, buildings, etc will enable Sinclair to reach college alumni, community members and area businesses with an enhanced trove of historical information.

Due to the amount of time required to properly complete the indexing and data entry of the photographs, the transfer of some the historical materials not properly housed in archival containers was not completed. Sinclair intends to complete these activities, however, in-house using existing staff, interns and volunteers. Consequently, since the primary goal of increased access was definitely accomplished, the success of the grant was not diminished in any way.

To this point in time there has been no press/media coverage of the grant. However, Sinclair's plan is to include this information in the coverage of the 125 year celebration activities to be held in 2012.
