I am the mentor for Union County Archives. Steve Badenshop is the project director. Steve has been working on the project since mid April and has spent approximately 56 hours working on the project. He has completed the foldering and boxing of the materials specified in his grant request.

Some examples of what has already been accomplished is the Civil Transcripts 7.0 cu.ft. and date range of 1831- 1947 and Civil Executions 5.3 cu.ft. and date range of 1820-1915.
