**OLMSTED HISTORICAL SOCIETY ARCHIVE RESTORATION & PRESERVATION
PROJECT**

Report as of December 31, 2022

As of December 31, 2022, the Archive Committee has purchased all supplies & equipment listed in our application for the Ohio Historical Records Advisory Board re-grant monies through the grant from the National Historical Publications & Records Commission. Attached are the invoices, checks and final expense report.

We have been organizing, categorizing, and properly preserving our extensive historical holdings in archival materials. We have created an Archive Request Form which can be found on our website. We have finalized the labeling and placing categorized materials for our over 250 Family Files in archival sleeves, file folders, boxes and placing them on metal shelving. An inventory of Family Files and pictures of this portion of our archival library has been placed on our website and Facebook page. Attached is our Family Files listing.

The Society is fortunate to have a large quantity of materials, approximately 450 cubic footage/number, that have been generously donated. In saying that, this project is far more extensive than originally thought. Under the grant timeline, we have clocked over 2500 volunteer hours. When you look at our before and after pictures, you can see we have been taking great strides in preserving the historical materials. These pictures are attached.

Preserving the Past and the Present for the Future

We are asking for a three month extension on this grant which would end on March 31, 2023.

The purchased supplies from the grant funds and matching funds have been depleted. Therefore, we require additional supplies to finish our categorized and labeled General File materials, which we have placed in archival boxes and on metal shelving. Our Finance Committee is meeting to approve our 2023 budget so that we can purchase additional supplies. Attached is our Map Box #1 and General File Archive Reference Library listings which records the main topic enclosed in each box. There are numerous sub-titles under each main topic.

This has been a monumental undertaking but our all-volunteer Archive Committee members have been diligently working to place our irreplaceable materials in archival safe resources. We are committed to completing our plan of "Preserving the Past for the Present and Future" generations. While executing and completing each phase of our grant project, we have discovered so much about our surrounding area's history that we are able to share with our members and the public. We have experienced increase inquiries from people doing research on their families, historical buildings and general historical information. Some of our area schools and organizations have approached the Society to do tours of our historical buildings and for students to do reports on the area's first settlers.

Through our promoting the archives and the Society, the public is becoming increasingly aware of what information we can offer them. We have been posting the grant award and our step-by-step progress in completing the grant objectives on our website and our Facebook page. We have contacted our local newspaper "The WestLife" and they would like to do a story on this grant and our archives. If granted, we agreed to do the story before the March 31, 2023, extended deadline.

We are looking toward the future to take our archival protected documents to digitalized holdings. We are currently researching computers, printers, scanners and the PastPerfect software. We are motivated in our labors to see the transformation of the Olmsted Historical Society's archive collections come into the 21st century by an online presence.
