Summary of Project Activities and Accomplishments

Summary of Project Activities and Accomplishments

Thanks to the support of the Ohio Historic Records Advisory Board (OHRAB) re-grant, we were able to identify, arrange, re -house, and develop a finding aid of the International Women's Air & Space Museum (IWASM)'s first 20 years of history from 1976-1996. Through this project we were able to:

Protect documents, photographs, blueprints, and other media relating the earliest years of the organization's activities. Make additional space available in our archival storage area and offices.

Arrange thousands of materials that tell the larger stories of IWASM activities, campaigns, publications, and governance as well as the local histories of the communities in which the museum operated.

For nearly 26 years, these historically significant records were stored in deteriorating, unsafe bankers' boxes or rusted file cabinets. Many of the boxes are scattered throughout multiple storage locations onsite at IWASM, while others were stored offsite for over a decade where they were exposed to water damage, uncontrolled temperatures and humidity, and other environmental factors. As part of our records survey implemented in 2021, we know that these records were not organized in accordance with archival best practices, and have been inaccessible for institutional research purposes. Due to this lack of organization and improper storage methods, our institutional history has never been made accessible to the public, the Board of Trustees, or our staff.

Over the course of the project, we had a staffing change but were able to successfully complete the project resulting in eight series: Governance, Financial, Correspondence, Activities & Programs, Images & Media, Publications & Marketing, Campaigns & Fundraising, and Personnel. Given the nature of the organization's history, and with the help of IWASM advisor Amy Rohmiller, we identified these series of big buckets to help us go through nearly 35 boxes, identify duplicate materials, and then break down by year within each series title. What resulted, ultimately was a finding aid and manuscript collection that will allow for future accrual. Due in large part to many concurrent projects, we found it difficult at times to dedicate the sole task of completing this project, especially in light of many activities that impacted the work, including the Burke Lakefront Airport fire suppression project that halted progress to allow the contractor access. Regardless of the disruptions, we were excited to explore some of the earlier histories of other organizations like the Ohio Museum Association, Centerville-Washington Township Historical Society and community, the 2003 Committee and IWASM's involvement in the push for a National Park for the Wrights and Paul Laurence Dunbar, and so much more. During the project, we also connected with the current staff at the Centerville-Washington Township Historical Society (CWTHS) and have shared information and images from when IWASM was located inside the Ashael Wright House. CWTHS has been interested in sharing what the space looked like and how the structure was used before they assumed control of the building in the 1990s.

With the Finding Aid complete for MS-021 IWASM Institutional Archives, we will be adding it to the museum's online catalog: iwasm.omeka.net. For the first time, the board and staff will have a chance to research the progress and initiatives of the first 25 years, as it turned out, of the organization as it begins looking to its 50th anniversary in 2026. Already the team is looking to digitize elements of the collection, and are looking to continue the process of documenting and organizing IWASM's organizational history by next addressing the years 1997-2003 – a time period that saw the move from Centerville and Dayton to Cleveland coinciding with the centennial of flight celebrations.



INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S AIR AND SPACE MUSEUM

The first stop on Dayton's Aviation Trail is a visit to The First Ladies of Flight

Saturday afternoon seems to be the perfect time for me to get in touch can be done with a good book seated in my favorite chair or, with just a little effort, it can be done by visiting one of the many sites on the Aviation Trail (the historic sites in the metropolitan Dayton area). One spot which may not be well known to some of you is the International Women's Air and Space Museum in Centerville.

During my recent visit. Margie McDonald, secretary and unofficial tour guide, told me how the museum started. Over fifteen years ago, the "first ladies" in aviation began to realize that with the passing of time (and their lives), the story of women in flight would be lost! They formed an organization and began to collect memorabilia before it disappeared in attics and incinerators. In March, 1986, almost four years ago, they opened to the public in the Wright House, at 26 North Main in Centerville. This charming house was built in 1806 by Ashael Wright, a great uncle of the Wright Brothers. It had been used by the city of Centerville as a meeting place but gradually they outgrew it.

The museum includes items from women that we are familiar with such as Amelia Earhart and Jackie Cochrane but also from many others including a featured exhibit on the Women Air Service Pilots. The WASP were a civilian branch of the U.S. Army Air Force who served from 1942 to 1944 to alleviate the shortage of male pilots. Minimum requirements for selection to the WASP included: a commercial pilot license, not less than 200 hours of logged flight time, and cross-country flying experience. The 1074 women pilots worked with the Air Transport Command, Third Air Force, Materiel Command, the Weather Wing, and the Flying Training Command at 134 bases throughout the United States. Understandably, they were insulted in the mid-1970's when the newspapers announced that the Air Force would train

its first "women military pilots." In 1979 (25 years after their active duty) they were awarded veteran status by the USAF!

Upstairs in the museum, a picture of a beautiful young woman and a dress form with a plum colored satin duster caught my eye. It was Harriet Quimby with what was probably the first attempt at a flight suit. In the air, Harriet could fasten the skirt of the coat around her legs for efficiency and safety. On the ground she unfastened it for a feminine appearance. Harriet had a remarkable although tragically short flying career. She was the first woman to pass the U.S. Aero Club's flight test but the all-male membership felt women were emotionally unfit to fly. However, they relented and she received license #37 on August 1, 1911. She was the first woman to fly solo across the English Channel (April 16, 1912) but this event was lost in the publicity over the Titanic's sinking! She was flying in an air show over Boston Harbor but was pitched from the plane and died on July 1, 1912. Her life and death seem to be of particular interest to students from Embry-Riddle. In their research they have tried to explain the cause of her tragic accident. There were no seat belts and they feel an air current may have been responsible for the plane's forward pitch.

The small group of ladies who make up the organization meet twice a year. Their goal is to have a larger building that will house airplanes significant to women's achievements in aviation and space. Secretary Margie described the president of IWASM, Nancy Hopkins Tier, as an 80-year-old bundle of energy. She lives in Connecticut but she has her own plane and still flies. She knows everyone (in women's aviation) and is always on the go. It is the vision of these women who will continue to inspire us and all women interested in flight!

A separate annex houses the space exhibit furnished by Rockwell International, a member of the IWASM board. The museum is non-profit and is open to visitors on Saturday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Office hours are Wednesday through Saturday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Special tours may be arranged by calling 433-6766.

Abstract

Records consist of organizational papers, annual reports, financial records, images and media of museum activities, programs and outreach, recruitment and fundraising campaigns for the International Women's Air & Space Museum (IWASM) starting in 1968, through its incorporation as a 501c3 nonprofit, through the end of 1996. The collection includes minutes of the Board of Trustees and committee meetings, officers and membership lists, annual reports, newsletters, financial records, an extensive collection of correspondence, press releases, clippings and materials relating to the IWASM membership in national and regional museum organizations. Also included are images, draft plans, records of the Museum Trust of the Ninety-Nines from 1968-1972 which highlights the early work of B Steadman, Joan Hrubec, Paige Shamburger, Doris Scott, and others in the creation and feasibility studies for the establishment of the International Women's Air & Space Museum.
